## Airstrike Exchange (SHOVEL)

Tensions between Hezbollah and Israel boiled over yesterday morning.

Hezbollah—the (lengthy-to-describe) Lebanon-based, Iran-backed, Hamas-allied militant group—had reportedly planned a rocket attack on northern Israel in retaliation for the assassination of its top commander last month. Israel says it learned of the attack and blunted it, striking thousands of Hezbollah rocket launchers so that "fifty percent, maybe two-thirds" of their rockets didn't liftoff.

Still, each side landed hundreds of blows, marking the heaviest exchange of airstrikes during a months-long back-and-forth. By mid-morning, skies had quieted, and Hezbollah's leader said its successful attack was over. Israel reported killing three Hezbollah fighters and sustaining "very little" home front damage.

The morning's conflict added fuel to fears of a regional war, but by afternoon, both sides had seemed to step back, avoiding escalation.

The group of swing states is often similar during each presidential election cycle, though factors like changing demographics and turnout can make a traditionally red or blue state turn purple. Georgia, for example, swung into the swing state category in the wake of Biden's surprise victory there in 2020 and Democratic Sen. Raphael Warnock's election win in 2022.

   Department released the Personal Consumption Expenditures Price Index
   2.5% down. GDP estimate is up from 2.8% to 3%.

  - Fresh data revealed that the Eurozone's annual inflation rate fell to a three-year low of 2.2% in August, driven by lower energy prices and base effects that curbed price growth, reinforcing expectations of another ECB rate cut in September.
